The inter-meeting course 'Introduction to meta-analysis in ecology' will take place at Coimbra, Portugal, between $3^{rd} - 7^{th}$ April 2017.

Introduction

Meta-analysis is a statistical tool for combining the results of primary studies on the same topic, taking into account study precision, to allow general conclusions and evaluation of the consistency of results across studies. As it is an objective and powerful tool for summarizing evidence, the number of meta-analyses in ecology has been rising in recent years. This course will introduce the basics of meta-analysis and make participants aware of this tool as well as prepared to evaluate its quality and interpret its results.



Travel: Arrival to Coimbra

If you are arriving to Portugal by plain, you can land in either Lisbon/Lisboa or Oporto/Porto. The best way to go from these cities to Coimbra is by train.

To go from Lisbon/Lisboa airport to Coimbra:

- **1a.** At the entrance of the airport you can take a **taxi to the train station Oriente** (the trip will take \sim 10 mins and cost \sim 10 Euros).
- **1b.** In alternative to the taxi, you can take the **subway from the airport to the train station Oriente** (the trip will take ~ 10 min and cost 1.40 Euros): once you leave the restricted area inside the airport, you should turn right and look for the subway symbol (still inside the airport); buy a ticket in a self-service machine or at the desk; take the subway and leave 3 stations after (**Oriente**; red line).
- 2. Take the next train to Coimbra (either Alfa or Intercidades; 19 23 Euros). The trip will take 1h30 2h00, and you will leave at Coimbra-B.
- 3a. Take a taxi to your residence.
- **3b**. In alternative, take a **train connection between Coimbra-B and Coimbra** (city centre) using the same train ticket you already have and **walk to your residence**.

To go from Oporto/Porto airport to Coimbra:

- 1a. At the entrance of the airport you can take a taxi to the train station Porto-Campanhã.
- **1b.** In alternative to the taxi, you can take the **subway from the airport to the train station Porto- Campanhã** (the trip will take ~ 30 min and cost 1.85 Euros): look for the subway symbol ; buy a ticket in a self-service machine or at the desk; take the subway and leave 19 stations after (**Campanhã**; purple line).
- **2.** Take the next **train to Coimbra** (either Alfa or Intercidades; 18 23 Euros). The trip will take $\sim 1h30$, and you will leave at **Coimbra-B**.
- 3a. Take a taxi to your residence.
- **3b**. In alternative, take a **train connection between Coimbra-B and Coimbra** (city centre) using the same train ticket you already have and **walk to your residence**.

Travel: Departure from Coimbra

In case you need to go to Lisbon/Lisboa or Oporto/Porto.

To go from Coimbra to Lisbon:

1a. Take a train (Alfa or Intercidades: Coimbra-B – Oriente). The trip will take 1h30 – 2h00 and cost 19 – 23

Euros.

1b. In alternative you can take an **Expresso bus** at Terminal Rodoviário, Rua Fernão Magalhães, Coimbra.

This is a good alternative only if you need to be at the airport very early in the morning and need to travel

to Lisbon during the night; for the trips made during the night the bus will stop at the departures' entrance

of the airport. The trip will take ~1h30 and cost 13.80 Euros.

To go from Coimbra to Oporto:

The best way to go from Coimbra to Oporto is probably by train.
